In an effort to decrease water demands during this period of drought, your water supplier, Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 50, needs your help to voluntarily conserve water. Whether it is watering your lawn only twice each week or merely turning off the faucet when you brush your teeth, working together we can make a significant impact on the amount of water consumed. Plus, conserving water not only protects a valuable resource, it decreases your water usage, which lowers your monthly bill.
