- 10. North Fort Bend Water Authority matters, including participation in the Water Provider Conservation Program, including water conservation committee matters.
- 11. Report regarding development in the District, including approve development financing agreements, amendments to development financing agreements, escrow agreements, cost sharing agreements, and consents to assignment of developer reimbursement rights.
- 12. Matters related to change in District engineer, including:
  - a. authorize execution of letters to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality and the Environmental Protection Agency designating the engineer to be the District's agent in dealing with the agencies;
  - b. adopt Resolution Changing District Office and Establishing Additional Out-of-District Meeting Place;
  - c. authorize execution of District Registration Form;
  - d. authorize update of Emergency Preparedness Plan;
  - e. authorize update of Critical Load Spreadsheet; and
  - f. authorize work of prior engineer on certain ongoing projects.
- 13. Engineering matters, including approve engineering proposals, authorize design, approve plans and specifications, authorize advertisement for bids,

review bids and award contracts, approve letter financing agreements, approve pay estimates and change orders, authorize final acceptance of projects, and direct engineer to notify insurance company, as appropriate, for the following:

- a. Water Plant No. 2 Expansion No. 1;
- b. wastewater treatment plant detention pond improvements;
- c. Sub-regional detention basin, storm sewer outfall and junction box and waterline project;
- d. water, sanitary sewer, and drainage facilities to serve Pacific Peek, Ltd. (District West mixed use development);
- e. generators at District lift stations;
- f. Fort Bend County Bellaire Boulevard right turn lane project;
- g. deeds, easements, appraisals, consents to encroachment, encroachment agreements, assignments of capacity, requests for service, utility conveyances, out-of-district service agreements, utility commitment letters, Phase I inspections, and conveyances of District property;
- h. geotechnical survey for area between Lost Creek Detention Ponds B and C;
- i. Fort Bend County sound wall installation project; and
- j. Capital Improvement Plan.

- 15. Geographic Information System matters, including consider amending Quiddity's Schedule of Hourly Rates and Reimbursable Expenses.
- 16. Report on maintenance of District detention ponds, facility sites, and other property, including:
